
HUMMERSKNOTT ACADEMY: REMOTE EDUCATION PLAN

The Remote Education Plan at Hummersknott provides immediate remote education and access to the curriculum via the following approach:



Remote Education for Self-Isolating Students (where not a whole class/year group):

• Paper based work

Will issued to those students identified by SLT as in need of it - all teachers to receive a definitive list of named students after half term. Set and posted out to students; work set will mirror the work be carried out in the lessons the student(s) is missing. The student must bring this work back into school at the end of their self-isolation.

• Oak Academy Lessons

Student(s) directed to the appropriate lessons and activities that match the work set.

Students to access and complete recorded lessons to support their understanding and learning of the work they are missing due to isolation.

This provides them with 'actual lessons' with teacher explanations and guidance to support the tasks set by their teachers.

• BBC Bitesize Activities

Student(s) directed to the appropriate lessons and activities that match the work set.

Student(s) to access the appropriate lessons and activities that match the work set and complete the tasks set.

Bitesize has Daily Lessons for the Autumn Term and a wide range of activities, quizzes and resources mapped against the national curriculum and exam board specifications.

• Websites

Students to use subject specific websites to support their remote education e.g. Mathswatch, Duolingo etc. as directed by their teacher.

• Remote Education Overview

Subjects to provide a very simple remote education over view – by topic/unit taught – for Oak, Bitesize and websites, followed by students and their parents when self-isolating. It will ensure our students access remote lessons delivered by teachers, whilst HA teachers continue to teach the students in school. Exercise books sent home, as students will complete this work in their books and this will be marked within normal marking. Students instructed to date and title this work as 'Remote Learning Work'.

• Microsoft TEAMs

TEAMs 'assignments' used to share resources/documents with students (replacing the use of the O Drive).

Students then also use 'assignments' to securely submit their work back to their teacher.

Remote Education for Self-Isolating Students (a whole class/year group):

• Microsoft TEAMs

For a whole class/year group bubble is self-isolating, lessons are to be taught to those students 'live' using TEAMs and will be delivered following the academy remote learning amended timetable timings:
